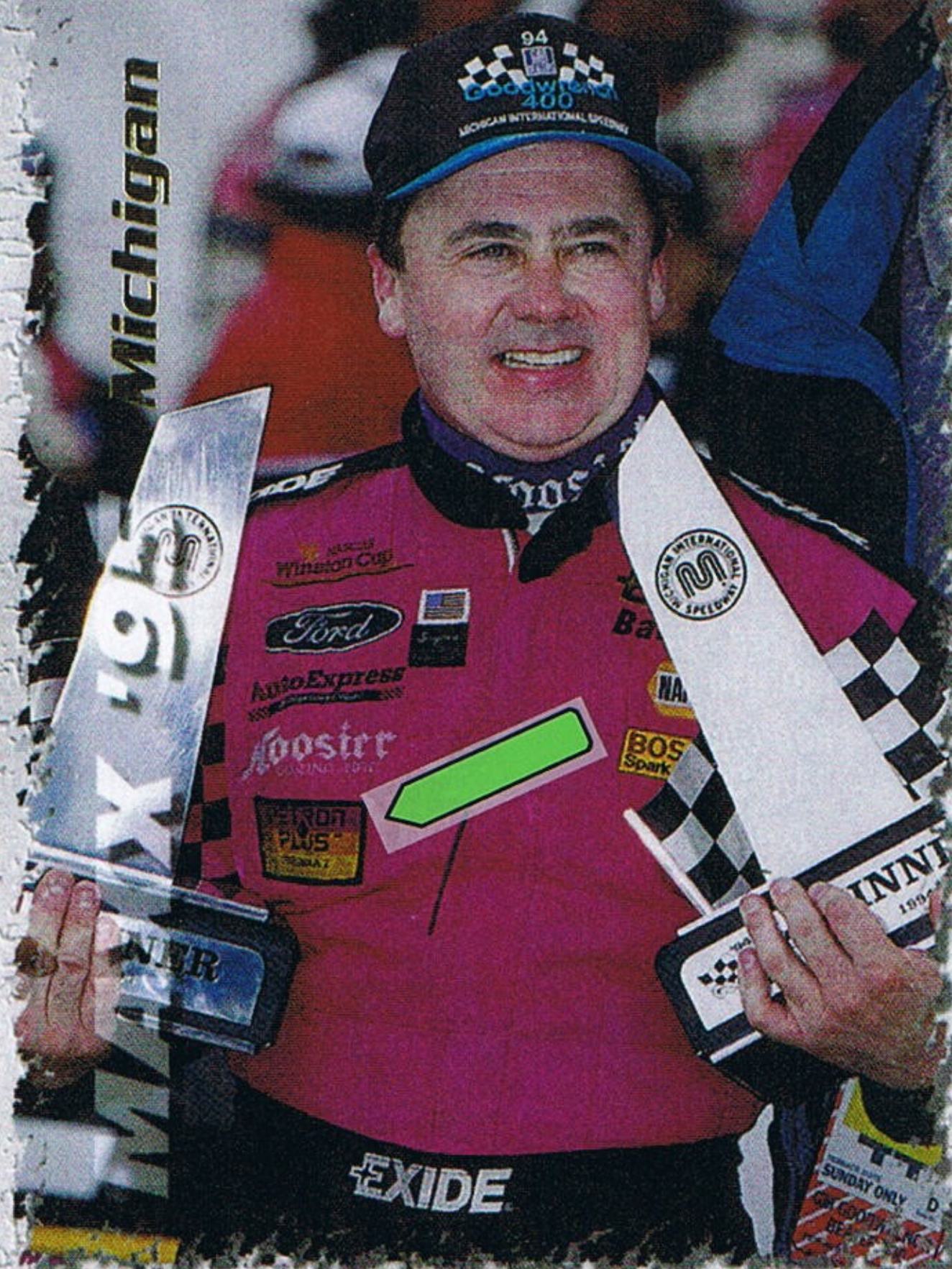

A varied array of racing circuits saw Geoff Bodine's fast moving shadow before he graduated to the Winston Cup ranks in 1979. In 1994, Bodine began his first full season as owner/driver of his own Fords.

Bodine's first win in '95 came in The Winston Select All-Star race where he dedicated the triumph to the late Alan Kulwicki, whose team he purchased in 1993. He went on to win races at Pocono, Michigan and North Wilkesboro in dominating fashion. At North Wilkesboro, Bodine started deep in the field and charged through the pack to win by over a lap. It was the first time a winner finished on a lap by himself in four years.

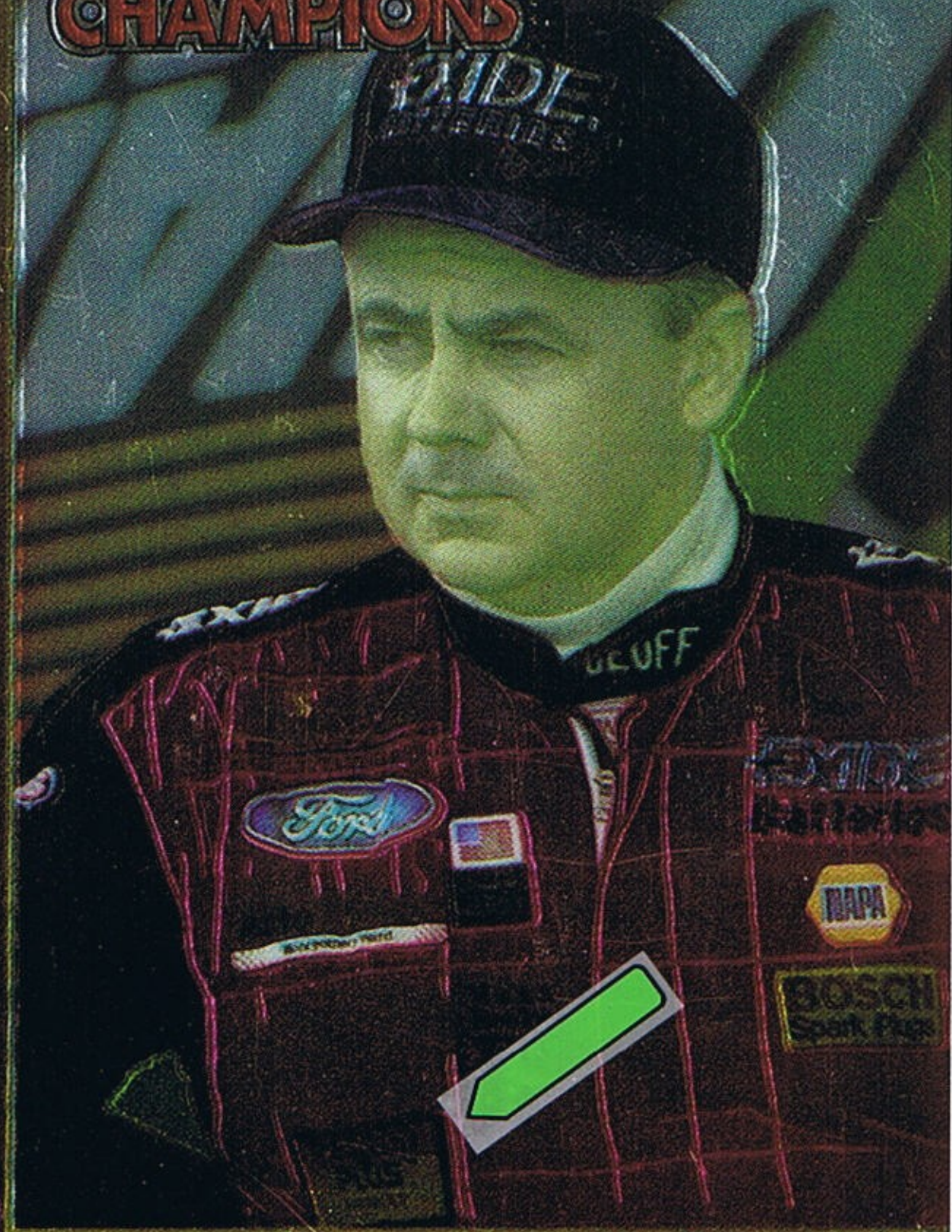

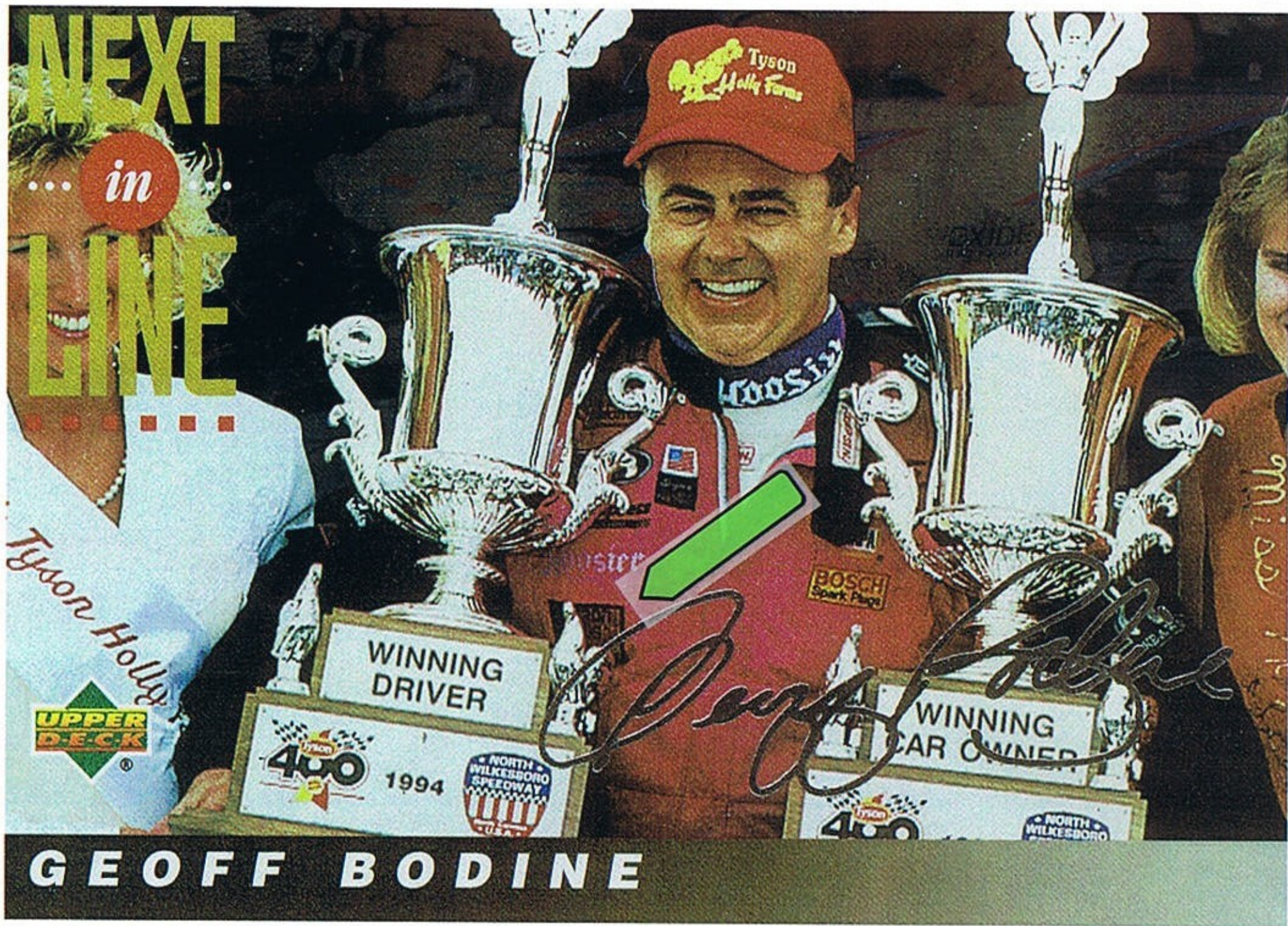

Bodine joined the growing ranks of owner/driver on the Winston Cup circuit in 1994 and guided his team to three victories plus a win in The Winston Select All-Star race at Charlotte Motor Speedway. One of a handful of drivers competing on Hoosier tires in 1994, Bodine also captured the Busch Pole Award with five pole-sitter wins and an equal number of outside pole victories. Hoosier will not return to the Winston Cup circuit in 1995, so Bodine will compete on Goodyear tires. That change should not keep the upstate New York native out of victory lane. He will again field his Exide Batteries Ford Thunderbird in 1995 and will be a strong contender for the Winston Cup championships.

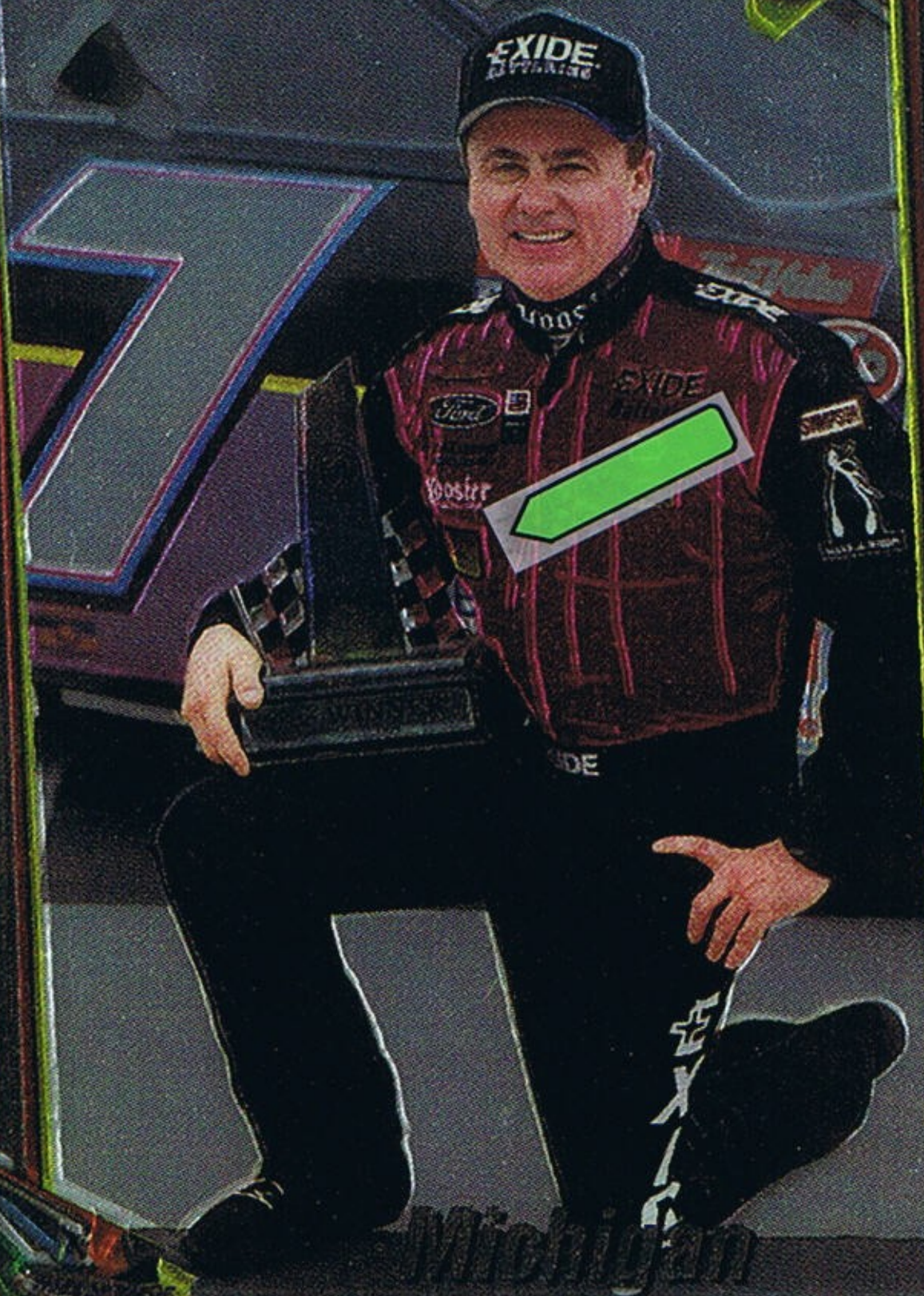
